## Criteria for the J.T. Crow Legacy Scholarship Fund

Purpose: The J.T. Crow Legacy Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college

bound high schools seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, community service, financial need and an interest in pursuing a degree in

the hard sciences.

Criteria:

(Students) Students eligible for assistance must be graduating seniors of Ennis High

School in Ennis, TX and intend to continue their education at a four-year college or university. Consideration will be given to academic excellence,

community service, and financial need.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and in equal payments in

August and January. Students must continue to attend classes and maintain no lower than a 3.0 grade point average, or equivalent.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be \$1000 annually, to be paid in two equal

installments.

Deadline: The application deadline is March 28th, 2024. The deadline is the date

after which applications will no longer be accepted.

Renewal

**Process:** This scholarship is not renewable. Only high school seniors intending to

enroll in a four-year college or university may apply. Previous scholarship

recipients cannot re-apply.

addenda and letters of reference, as well as a 300-500 word essay
