### End of school year medication pick up notice:

All Medications should be picked up by the last day of school. The office is open until June 29 for

medication pick up. Any medication left at school over the summer must be discarded according to Oregon Education Law, even if it is not expired. We look forward to receiving necessary medication for your student next fall. **Report Cards:** The office will mail report cards on Tuesday, June 21. If you have moved recently.... or anytime during this school year... please contact the office to ensure that we have your **correct mailing address**. The office closes on June 29 this year. Any report cards returned after this date will be processed when we return in August so please make sure we have the correct address for you! Thank you!

#### **Drinking Water Testing Underway**

Parents may be aware of recent news out of Portland, Oregon and around the country that elevated levels of lead were found to be present in some school sinks and fountains. In light of this news, Bend-La Pine Schools is taking precautionary steps to ensure safe water supplies. Although there are no water testing requirements for schools in Oregon, Bend-La Pine Schools has begun voluntarily testing its schools' drinking water for lead.

Bend-La Pine Schools received test kits and has just completed the collection of drinking water samples from our schools. In all, samples from 38 school/program sites were collected this week and are now at a local, professional lab. The lab will be testing for the presence of lead and results are expected to back to us in the next two to three weeks. For convenience as we near summer vacation, the web page https://www.bend.k12.or.us/district/newsevents/alerts-updates will be utilized to provide updates about the work and the test results, as it becomes available. Our communities' water providers are required to test water on a regular basis.

Some of our school sites have been included in these tests. We have had no reports that water tests in our communities have ever shown unsatisfactory levels of lead in the water supply. Bend-La Pine Schools takes the health and safety of students and staff seriously. Lead in water is a concern because high lead levels can contribute to negative health effects, especially for pregnant women, infants and young children under 6 years old. If you have any concerns about lead exposure, please see the resources below and/or contact your healthcare provider.

**USA Triathlon's Duathlon National Championships** are taking place in Bend, OR for the first time ever! Sprint and Standard races will be hosted on June 25, 2016, with Summit High School serving as the hub for all race-day activity. 2014 and 2015 called Saint Paul, MN come with the race pulling athletes from 45 states! In 2016, we expect all 50 states to be represented by the best run-bike-run athletes in the nation. USA Triathlon will offer two race distances for the event — a standard distance 10k run, 40k bike and 5k run, and a 5k run, 20k bike, 2.5k run for the sprint distance.

Racing is scheduled to begin at 7:30am on Saturday, June 25 and continue until 4:30pm.
