The cost for this work will be detailed in a Guaranteed Maximum Price #6 contract amendment between the District and the Construction Manager, pending final negotiation of terms by District legal counsel. The work will be substantially complete along with the balance of interior modifications at the Secondary Campus awarded in other packages by the end of summer 2024.
