# **Grade Level Convocation Re-Opening Plan**

## **In-person instruction :**

- April 12, 2021
- Group 1 Last Name A-L
  - Monday/Tuesday
  - Periods 1-5 / 6-9+ Study Hall
- Group 2 Last Name M-Z
  - Thursday/Friday
  - Periods 1-5 / 6-9+ Study Hall
- School bell schedule A/B days-  
Wednesday remote learning



- Students must remain in their homeroom the entire day
- Lunch period- additional time (study hall)

### Ingress instructions

- Students to line up outside six feet apart
- Mask must be worn at all times
- Temperature checks at the door
- Feet must be disinfected with the floor mat
- Hand sanitizer upon entering
- there will be designated entrance for each grade level
- After entering the building students must report directly to their homeroom

- Doors open at 8AM (Grab and go breakfast)
- School day begins with HR, Periods 1-5 (or 6-9/study hall)
- Dismissal 1:30PM (student must wait for dismissal) announcement by classroom-Grab and go Lunch
- **NO Locker Use**
- You must bring chromebook, headphones, water (closed plastic), masks
- Bathroom breaks will be limited to 5 minutes between webex
  - Masks must be worn at all times, doubled masks are encouraged
  - Students must be escorted to the bathroom by security or administrator

- Students will not be allowed in school without school ID
