ACP meetings & Registration

ACP: Academic Career Plan Your counselor will meet with you individually to go over:

- Current grades
- Graduation progress & final requirements
 - -Credits, SOLs
- Update your Academic & Career Plan (ACP) including:
 - -Plan for after High School (work, military, 2 year college, 4 year college, etc...)
 - -plan of course selections for your last year of high school

Registration: March 6th-21st

- Register for classes for Parent/Student Portal at home during the window
- Course of Studies (List of all classes and class descriptions) available online on MCHS web page

Credits

- To move from 11th grade to 12th grade a student must have earned enough credits to enable him or her to complete any remaining courses in time to graduate by May of the upcoming school year.
- Athletic eligibility
 - -You must pass 3 out of 4 classes the semester prior to be eligible to play
 - -Winter sports: January semester change is crucial
 - -You must be enrolled in at least 3 classes (*in case you're considering release blocks)

Dual Enrollment Classes

- Dually enrolled at MCHS and Germanna Community College
- College credit is through Germanna
 - Transferrable to other community colleges and 4 year schools
- Full weight for GPA calculation
- Qualifying GPA, Virginia Placement Test or qualifying SAT/ACT scores
- Student/parent pays out of pocket, however, at a discounted rate (this year's tuition = \$57.13/credit)
- 11th /12th grade DE options: English (11 & 12), US History, Pre Calculus, Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Teacher for Tomorrow (Note: TFT is through Shenandoah, not GCC)

Advanced Placement Classes

- Colleges want to see you challenge yourself with higher level classes
- Once you sign up, COMMITT!
 - Summer Assignment (required for some)
 - College Level Work
 - AP Exam
- This year, MCPS is covering the cost of AP exams (students must take the AP exam to get the weighted credit for gpa calculation)
- •AP courses offered: 12th grade AP Government, AP Biology & other AP opportunities via Virtual Virginia and for BRVGS students

March course registration is very important!!! Class changes after this point will be at a minimum!

2 Year Community College

- Earn an Associate Degree
- Transfer to a 4 year college or university
 - -Freshmen and Sophomore year at a 2 year college
 - -Junior and Senior year at a 4 year college
 - -Guaranteed Admissions Program

4 Year University

- Earn a Bachelor's Degree
- 15 public colleges in VA

 cheaper cost due to state
 funding
- 32 private colleges in VA

 More expensive, but have
 scholarship opportunities if you
 have good grades and SAT/ACT
 scores

Visits

- College rep. Visits (sign up through Naviance)
- College campus field trips (Ms. Rhodes)
- Military Recruiters (during lunches and sign ups through Naviance)
- Business and Industry visits (sign up through Naviance)

SAT

- Sign up at <u>www.collegeboard.org</u>
 - March 8th (register by Feb. 21st)
 - May 3rd (register by April 18th)
 - June 7th (register by May 22nd)
- Most test once spring of junior year and then retest fall of senior year
- Send your scores to the colleges you are interested in applying to
- See your school counselor for a fee waiver if you qualify
- Study on collegeboard.org website, Naviance Student, and through the MCHS library database
- SAT is now digital (started March 2024) see your counselor if you need a MCPS chromebook for testing (with specific software for testing)

ACT

- Sign up at www.actstudent.org
 - April 5th (register by February 28th)
 - June 14th (register by May 9th)
 - July 12th (register by June 6th)
- ACT has a science section

ASVAB

- There is typically a fall and a spring administration
 -Spring administration is April 15th
- Helpful in exploring career options
- Necessary if considering enlistment
- (Can also take the ASVAB with a recruiter, separate from school)
- See Ms. Temple (Testing Coordinator) if you have questions regarding signing up to take the ASVAB
