Recommended curriculum, textbook adoption, and evaluation cycle should occur as follows:

1. Spring, year one - - - form committee
2. Fall, year two - - - study, research, and write goals for curriculum
3. Spring, year two - - - text selection
4. Fall, year three - - - implement curriculum
5. Spring, year three - - - evaluate new curriculum

Each area above is reviewed for necessary major revision on the cycle. Each program is to be under continuous evaluation/review to see that they meet the needs of students – i.e., standardized testing results, classroom observation, etc. Provisions will be made for an interim review of any curriculum area that becomes the object of students, staff, or parent questions.
