Concert Information

Dear K-2 Families,

As the Holidays approach, your kindergarten, first, and second grade students have been working hard in preparation for our **Winter Holiday Concert!**

The concert will be held on **WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 6th.**

The concert will begin at **6:30 PM.**

It will take place in the **auditorium** at **Slippery Rock Area HIGH SCHOOL.**

I ask that you please bring your performing student(s) to **meet me in the lobby** outside of the auditorium from **6:00-6:10** so that we can get organized prior to the performance.

The concert itself will **begin promptly at 6:30** and last approximately **60 minutes.**

The facilities will be accessible for individuals of all abilities, and the lobby will be available for any younger audience members who might need a personal intermission -- so bring on the younger siblings :)

Any and all are welcome to attend, and admission is **free** of charge.

You are welcome to **leave with your student after their portion** of the concert concludes, as they will be performing as grade levels rather than a combined group.

Before leaving with your student, please **check them out at the HS Library** right outside the auditorium.

Please be patient with all volunteers, as safety is our priority and younger students may take an extra moment to settle and organize in this brand new environment.

The students will also participate in an **all-school assembly** earlier in the week that will be **closed to families**.

This is a **SEPARATE** event from the evening concert and will take place at SRAE School.

Students do **NOT** need to dress up for this assembly performance.

Students may wear any outfit deemed appropriate by their families and may dress in any color scheme.

I ask that the students be able to **move and stand comfortably in their outfits for long periods of time**, as we will be performing on choral risers and moving efficiently through the hallways backstage.

I encourage festive apparel and the opportunity to dress up for the evening, but I also understand that not all have access to or feel comfortable in those items. **I leave this to your family's discretion.**

I feel strongly about the importance of family support in all endeavors and hope that you will be able to attend the evening performance to cheer on your student.

If you are unable to attend or have family members/etc. that are unable to do so, please know that **I will record the concert** and upload it to a safe viewing platform so that you are able to watch it at a later time. More information regarding these links will be sent out after the concert.

Your student's attendance at this concert is an **expectation** of their participation in the Slippery Rock Area Music Curriculum. Your students have worked hard and spent a lot of time in preparation for this performance. At SRAE, we have **ONE** public K-2 performance a year, and music (as many of the other activities in which your students participate) is a team "sport". Every student missing from that stage will affect their peers and the performance that they have **ALL** worked toward. That being said, **please provide a courtesy message and notify me of any extenuating circumstances as soon as possible at greer_wardlaweslipperyrock.k12.pa.us** so that I can prepare appropriately for any necessary absences. As a reminder, music is not a graded class (Pass/Fail only), and no repercussions will occur as a result of any absences.
