

K5-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be participating in pre-assessments required by the SC State Legislature, Act 142, passed June 2020. Students will be pre-assessed in both reading and math and a post test will be given before the end of the calendar year. We will begin testing students, **including our virtual students**, during our LEAP week . If you have a child in Grades 1-5, please make sure your child brings his/her Chromebook, fully charged, to school each day. Our testing window will go through September 16th.
