Formative Assessment Task

Kindergarten: Counting and Cardinality

K.CC.2. Count forward beginning from a given number within the known sequence (instead of having to begin at 1).

Directions:

- 1. Copy the attached game board, Numbers to the left and right. Create one copy for each pair of students. Copy and cut the cards and place them face down in a pile.
- 2. The pair of students take turns drawing a card and placing it in the correct spot on the game board. After they place a number on the game board, they need to justify why the number belongs in that space.
- 3. Keep going until all cards have been placed on the game board.

Considerations:

Watch how students discuss and place the numbers on the game board.

- Listen to the type of conversations students make about the placement of the numbers. For example, do they discuss the ones and tens place?
- Do they use the anchor number on the game board to justify their placement? To differentiate for struggling learners, create a new game board and new numbers on their level.

Collecting Data:

Student performance can be scored with a provided task rubric or a rubric created by the teacher.

Data can be recorded on a scoresheet.
