Kindergarten Readiness-Things to Practice Over the Summer

- **Language** (Talk, talk, and talk some more. Point out and interact in the world around them. Your modeling matters.)
- Play (imaginary, creative, building, board games, Simon Says)
- **Social** (collaborative play: sharing, waiting turn, problem solving, winning/losing with grace)
- **Emotional Regulation** (Feelings, calm body, strategies to handle disappointment)
- Student Skills (Taking direction from adults, speaking, listening, sustained attention)
- Independence (Manage belongings, follow directions, recognize name)

We are a closed enrollment school district so you will need to provide proof of residency (see below), Original birth certificate, shot records, and custody papers (if applicable)

- Please provide your driver's license or state ID with CURRENT address and two (2) recent home-related bills showing entire document, including name and service location, if applicable. Acceptable bills include, but are not limited to: mortgage, lease, water, sewer, NIPSCO, cable, internet, landline phone.
- If you do not have these in your name or your spouse's name, a residency affidavit is required. We will need the student's parent/guardian AND the homeowner to bring the required documents for proof and complete this at the Administration Office located behind Hobart Middle School. You MUST schedule an appointment for an affidavit at <u>www.hobart.k12.in.us/residencyaffidavit</u>
- Residency Affidavits must be completed within 30 days from registration.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

"You're off to great places! Today is your day! Your mountain is waiting So... get on your way!"

- August 14th is the First Day of Kindergarten
 - This will be a memorable day for you and your child together. We are inviting each student to attend the first day of school with one parent.
 - It will be a great opportunity for the child to attend school for a short period of time **(1 hour)** with his/her parent to visit the classroom.
 - Get to know the teacher, learn classroom/school expectations, gather important information, drop off supplies, take school picture, and pay book rental.
 - The remainder of the school day will be completed at home through **eLearning** to complete important activities to set up routines, learn technology, and prepare for the school year.
