<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p><u>Link to BV instructional video for week of March 23-27, 2020</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday (3/23): Write addition sentences using family member's first names. Add together consonants and vowels (a, e, i, o, u). Ex: Luke ($2 + 2 = 4$) Tuesday (3/24): Draw a picture and write an equation for this problem. "There are 8 clouds in the sky. 2 float away. How many clouds are left?" Wednesday (3/25): Draw and cut out 8 flowers. use them to show different ways to make 8. Write the equations for each way to make 8. Thursday (3/26): Write your numbers as high as you can. See if you can get to 100. Circle your 5's and 10's numbers. Look out for backward numbers! Friday (3/27): Count how many doors and windows are in your house. Compare. What do you have more of? Less of? Record your answer by drawing a bar graph.
