- 1. **argument** an attempt to persuade someone on a topic open to debate
- 2. **author's point of view** how the author feels about the situation or topic
- 3. **claim/thesis** a statement of the author's point of view
- 4. **counterclaim** an opposing claim that disagrees with the thesis
- 5. **credible source** a reliable resource the writer can use to cite information
- 6. **formal style** using a professional choice of words and tone/attitude
- 7. **reasoning** the explanations of why the author feels the way he or she does
- 8. **refute** to disprove a statement or theory
- 9. <u>relevant evidence</u> facts, details, examples, etc. that support the writer's reasoning
- 10. **sound** a way to describe an argument when it's based on logic/common sense
- 11. <u>sufficient evidence</u> when there's enough support to make the argument convincing
- 12. <u>transitions</u> words, phrases, or clauses that help the reader see how your ideas fit together to support your topic
