

## **Kangas from Kenya!**

**Objective:** Students will explore the culture of Kenya and design their own Kanga cloths

**Supplies:** White copy paper, pencils, erasers, colored pencils, rulers, markers, paint-- any type of colors will work!

**Monday:** Students will explore the culture of Kenya and the Kanga cloths

**Tuesday:** Students will sketch a design of their Kanga cloths on a piece of white copy paper. Your design must include a patterned border surrounding a central motif and a "proverb", quote, or phrase. YOUR SKETCH IS A PART OF YOUR GRADE!!

**Wednesday:** Students will transfer their sketch onto a piece of large white paper (if you don't have large paper, copy paper will work)

**Thursday:** Students will color their Kanga cloths

**Friday:** Students will finish their Kanga cloths. **Make sure you keep your sketch with your final project!**
