- 7. Name two reasons the photojournalists turned to using drugs.
- 8. Describe what happened in the aftermath of Carter's famous image of the famine-struck girl and the vulture. (You can view this image in yesterday's slideshow as well.)
- 9. Carter eventually began working free-lance. Explain what this means (look it up) and explain why it might be risky.
- 10. Although Carter was receiving a Pulitzer Prize for his image, there was a lot of backlash. What criticism did he face (such as the Florida Times)?
- 11. What happened when Carter returned from Mozambique?
