### Community

Knightstown High School is located in Knightstown, Indiana of Henry County, 10 miles east of Greenfield, Indiana and approximately 30 miles from Indianapolis, Indiana. It is primarily a rural area with a few businesses with a population of less than 3,000. Many of our student's parents work outside of the area and travel between 20-60 miles to work.

### School System and Demographics

Charles A. Beard School Corporation enrolls approximately 1,050 students' grades K-12. The three schools; (Knightstown Elementary (Pre K-3), Knightstown Intermediate School (4-8), and Knightstown High School (9-12) offer a wide variety of academic, athletic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities in an attempt to meet the varied interest and abilities of our student body. KHS offers the following Honors courses: Honors English 9, Honors English 10, Honors English 11, Honors Chemistry, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra II, and Pre-Calc. KHS offers the following advanced placement courses: AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Chemistry, AP Language & Composition, AP Literature & Composition, AP Physics, AP Pre-Calculus, AP US History, AP 2D Art. Dual credit options include and Advanced Chemistry and Physics. KHS also has many cooperative educational opportunities for students through the New Castle Area Career Programs.
