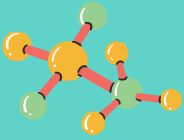


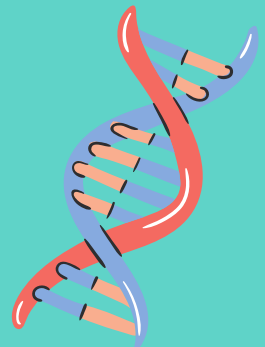
Are you a secondary science teacher (grades 6-12)? Are you implementing NGSS?
