#### An Introduction to the Orchestra

## Kindergarten Lesson for week of April 27

**Focus:** This week we will begin looking at the instruments of the orchestra.

What is an orchestra? What do you think an orchestra is?

What is a family? We all have a family. Our family may look different from someone else's family but they are both still a family. In our families, we have similarities. We may look like, sound like or simply like to do something the same as someone else in our family.

Just like us, instruments have families. There are four main families of instruments that are found in the orchestra. Strings, Percussion, Woodwind and Brass.

#### The Percussion Family:

Percussion instruments are any instrument that you hit, shake or scrape. Can you think of an instrument that would be in the percussion family?

Last week I encouraged you to drum for 5 minutes. I encourage you to do the same this week but think of different ways that you could create a percussion instrument at home.

# The String Family:

String instruments are instruments that use strings to produce their sound. Can you think of an instrument that would be in the string family? Some string instruments are not typically found in the orchestra. Normally, we do not see guitars, mandolins or banjos in an orchestra. But they are in the string family.

## The Woodwind Family:

This family is the most diverse (different). Woodwinds used to be made of wood and you blow into it for it to sound. What instruments do you know that might be a woodwind?
