Focus on Sustainability

- LEED Certified Building (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design)
- We use dishes and silverware (as opposed to waxed boats and plastic silverware)
- Solar Panels on our roof provide some on our electricity and are a great learning tool for our students
- We compost all of our uneaten food
- We have Green Teams that focus on Reducing, Reusing and Recycling
- We use Electronic Communications but can provide paper copies if requested
- We have Outdoor Classrooms on each of our playgrounds

Reaching all Students

- Four expectations for our students: Be safe, kind, responsible and green
- Academic support and extensions in reading, writing and math
- Levels of Support: Health Protocols, 504 plans, Speech and Special Education
- Monthly character trait focus.
- Assemblies: We celebrate our school and our staff and students. We have fun!
- Each school day begins with a Morning Meeting to build classroom community so students can work and learn together in a calm and inviting atmosphere
- Buddy Classes: Each 3rd 5th grade class has a Kinder 2nd grade buddy class
- Technology: Kindergarten 5th grade each student has their own iPad. These get used very little in kinder and more often with each grade level jump.

Parent Involvement

- Volunteers must complete an online application and pass the background check to volunteer in Bend – La Pine Schools. You will be notified by email either way.
- Some teachers use parent volunteers, others do not. As a volunteer you may work with students or complete prep work for classroom teachers.
