

Know the Kingdoms!

In this project you will work in groups of two and research one of the six kingdoms. You will use the iPads to determine certain characteristics and facts about your kingdom and then design a poster to represent what you have learned. Tomorrow these posters will be displayed around the room and you can collect information about the other five kingdoms!

Groups will consist of two students. One student will research the information on the rubric that has an * next to it and the other student will research the criteria without an asterisk. You can decide on who will draw the picture.
