King Harold of England

1022-1066 CE

King during the Battle of Hastings, in which he was killed. He was the last Anglo-Saxon King.

William the Conqueror

1028-1087 CE

Led the Norman Conquest. Took the throne from Harold and became the first Norman King of England.

King Henry II

1133-1189 CE

Was the great grandson of William the Conqueror. Ruled with law and order. Created different courts. Married to Eleanor of Aquitaine.

King Richard the Lion-Hearted

1157-1199 CE

Leader during the Crusades.

Rebelled against his father, King

Henry II. Was known for being very

brave during the wars.

King John

1166-1216 CE

Was Richard's younger brother, and not favored as a King. He lost many lands in France and was later forced to sign the Magna Carta. Was also excommunicated by the Pope.
