Fine Arts Boosters Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Monticello Fine Arts Boosters is an active group of parents who support Monticello's fine arts programs by fundraising through various avenues. We support the programs by improving equipment, materials, and costuming that the school might not otherwise be able to provide. We also host a variety of events such as the Dessert Concert and Jammin' in January. We have been fortunate to provide monetary assistance to students attending the bi-annual trips as well as helping with costs associated with other traveling competitions and events.

The Monticello Fine Arts Boosters organization is pleased to offer a scholarship opportunity of \$500 to qualified applicants according to the following guidelines:

- 1) The Fine Arts Boosters Scholarship Application is available from the High School Counseling Office. This application must be completed, signed, and submitted to the Counseling Office (along with all necessary attachments and documents) by the April 1 deadline.
- 2) To qualify for the scholarship process, the student must meet the following criteria:
 - a) Cumulative high school GPA of 3.0
 - b) Been involved in high school choir or band 3 of the 4 years
 - c) Must be pursuing a music-related major in college
- 3) The \$500 scholarship, if awarded, will be paid directly to your college after you have successfully completed one semester. You must provide proof of completion of the semester with a minimum of 3.0 GPA by transcript or grade sheet, reflecting a music-related major and showing music class and/or participation in a music group. This information should be submitted to Mr. Kniess, along with the address of your college financial aid office and your student ID number.

Applications received in a timely fashion will be reviewed by the Monticello Fine Arts Boosters and a selection will be made by vote. The winner(s) will be announced at the Honors Night ceremony.

The \$500 Monticello Fine Arts Boosters Scholarship is a non-renewable, one-time award. Good luck! We wish you all the best in your college quest.

Kitty Creek Quartet Scholarship Application Guidelines

The guidelines for this scholarship align with those of the Fine Arts Boosters.

The Kitty Creek Quartet was made up of musicians who took pride in sharing their musical talents with fans from across the country. This Monticello-based group used the proceeds from their shows to benefit the community. One of the ways this group keeps its mission is through this scholarship of \$500 to qualified applicants according to the following guidelines:

- 1) The Kitty Creek Quartet Scholarship Application is available from the High School Counseling Office. This application must be completed, signed, and submitted to the Counseling Office (along with all necessary attachments and documents) by the April 1 deadline.
- 2) To qualify for the scholarship process, the student must meet the following criteria:
 - a) Cumulative high school GPA of 3.0
 - b) Been involved in high school choir or band 3 of the 4 years
- 3) The \$500 scholarship, if awarded, will be paid directly to your college after you have successfully completed one semester. You must provide proof of completion of the semester with a minimum of 3.0 GPA by transcript or grade sheet.
