

Greetings from Kiwanis Club of Monroe!

This year the Kiwanis Club of Monroe is pleased to award three scholarships and we would like to invite any Union County high school senior to apply.

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who possesses strong character, a demonstrated belief in service to the community, and academic evidence predicting success in college. **The purpose of the scholarship is to help a student who can be successful in college but may not receive financial assistance elsewhere**. The recipient may pursue higher education at the institution of his/her choice.

Details of award:

- A \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to each of the three students selected.
- Funds will be paid directly to the college at the beginning of the student's first year to be used for tuition, books, or room and board.

Criteria for the scholarship:

- Resident of Union County
- Graduating senior from any public, private, or home-school program.

The selection committee will review applications to determine finalists for the scholarship. After a personal interview with each finalist, the recipient will be selected by the committee.

A complete application packet consists of:

- 1. The attached application
- 2. High school transcripts
- 3. Resume
- 4. Essay chosen from the listed topics.

Finalists will be selected for personal interviews based on the following criteria:

- Academics
- Character
- Community service
- Essay

Completed applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2024. No late applications will be accepted.

 - 3. Tell us about a time where you demonstrated leadership.

All essays should be typed and double-spaced.
