Tdap for next year's 7th Graders

The State of Montana requires a Tdap vaccine prior to entering 7th grade. This is a booster shot for the DTaP immunization series students received back around kindergarten days. If we do not have Tdap on file, you will have already received multiple notifications. Please note, your student will not

be able to attend 7th grade at KMS, if proof of vaccine/ exemption is not provided. To make this process as convenient as possible, we are offering multiple ways to provide immunization records.
