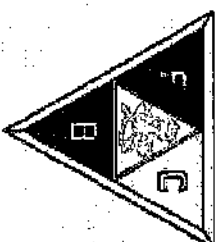

CONTEST ENTRY INFORMATION

FOR ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Knights of Pythias Poster / Visual Arts Contest entitled "*Go Green, Help Save The Earth*" is open to any student enrolled as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior in any Junior or Senior High Public or Parochial School in Indiana, or to home-schooled students who are equivalent age and grade.

Rules and Regulations

1. Poster may be on any color cardboard, 14 inches X 22 inches (35.6 cm X 55.9 cm) uniformly. **DO NOT DEVIATE**
2. Any two-dimensional medium may be used. (computer graphics, photography, stenciling, drawing, painting, etc.)
3. All the art must be **ORIGINAL**. No copyrighted material may be used in the development of, or in the actual entry.
4. On the front of the Poster near the bottom, in letters not over 1/4 inch high, must appear the following:
"SPONSORED BY THE FRATERNAL ORDER KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS"
5. There will be equal prizes given for computer generated posters and for hand painted or drawn posters.

6. The local Lodge will be in charge of the local contest in its jurisdiction. (See list of Regions on back). The local Lodge must receive all entries by April 1st, and will then determine the local winner.

7. All posters entered in any and all contests become the property of the Knights of Pythias.

8. Entrants name, address, phone, school and grade must be on back of poster.

ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED TO QUALIFY FOR JUDGING

The winners of all contests (local, State, and Supreme) will be determined by qualified judges.

The posters will be judged on the following criteria:

- Message
- Originality
- Effective display of message in specified dimension
- Neatness
- Adherence to stated rules and regulations

**Winners at the State level will be notified
by June 20, 2022**

Poster Tips:

- 1) Message must be understood at a glance
- 2) Message and artwork – the simpler the better
- 3) Color is great!
- 4) Check with your local advertising company for advice
- 5) Ask your Art Instructor to review
