




Know. 10 Lesson 3, use ckla activity page 3.1, star, start left to right glue pics on the bread



Draw what the sheep looked like BEFORE it was sheared






Know. 10 Lesson 5, trace measure, circle measure pics, circle pics the hatter might use beaver skin, wool, camel fur, and glue




