



























**Kindergarten I Knowledge 5

7. Harvest: Do we harvest crops by planting seeds?	 
8. Grains: Are wheat, oats, and corn grains used to make food?	 
9. Shelter: Would you go inside a shelter if it's raining?

11. Collects: If a farmer collects eggs, could he sell them at a market?	 
12. Valuable: Are farm machines, like tractors, valuable?	 
13. Ripe: Is it best to eat strawberries when they are ripe?	 



















14. **Spoil:** If you leave a glass of milk sitting in the hot sun for a long time, will it spoil?
