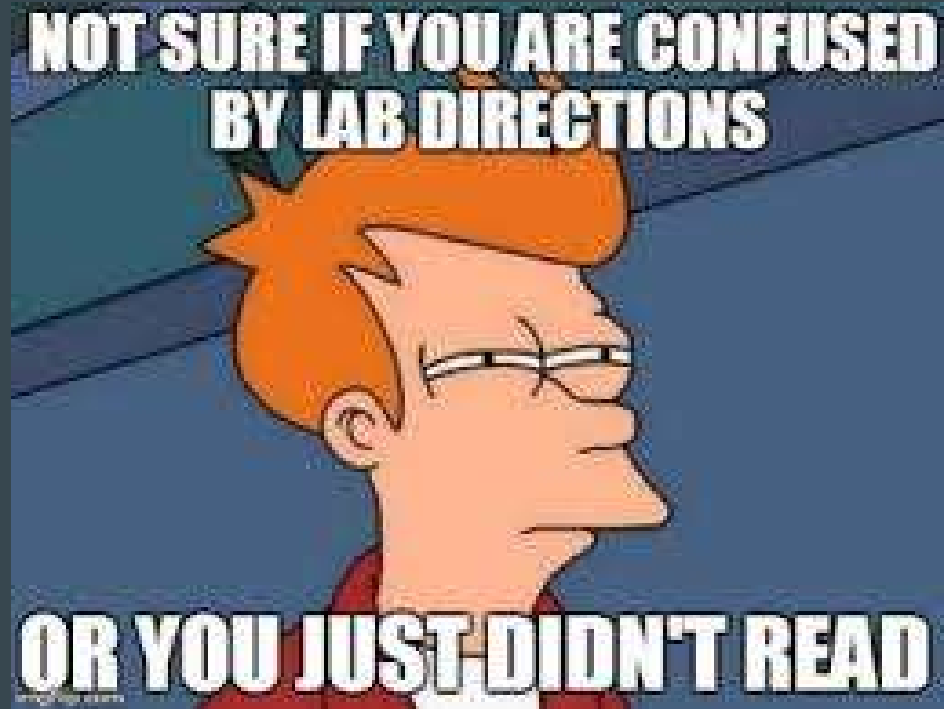


# Lab Safety

**Report all accidents to teacher immediately.**



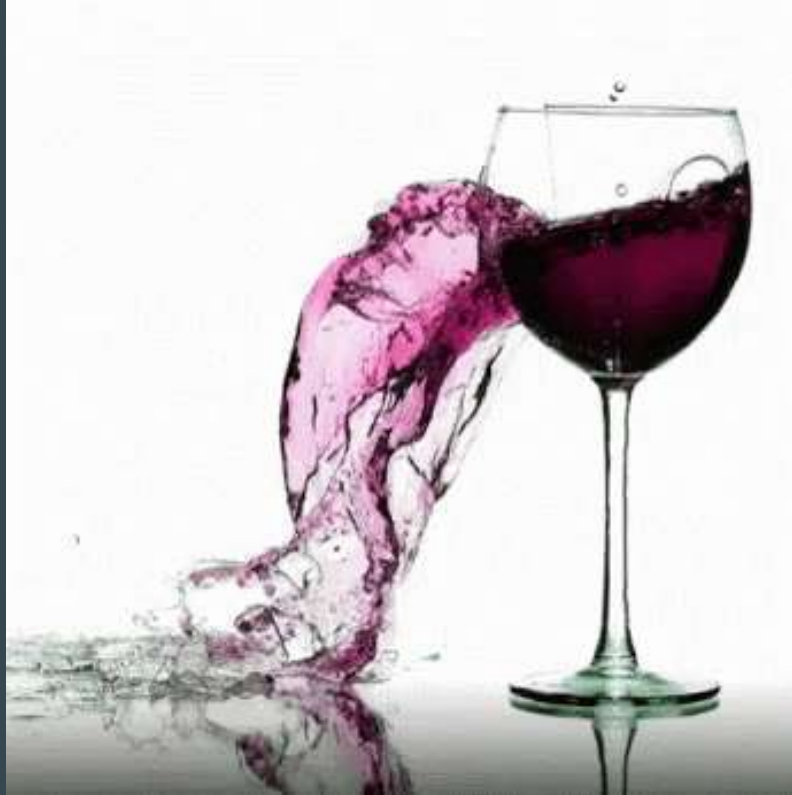
**Tie back long hair and do not wear dangling jewelry or loose, baggy clothes.**
