

LAKE VIKING LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

1. GUIDELINES:

The Lake Viking Lions Club will award two \$500 scholarships annually. One scholarship will be awarded to a Gallatin High School senior and one to a Winston High School senior.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

A. Achieved a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (4.0 scale) covering grades 9 through the first semester of grade 12.

B. Plans to attend an approved (accredited) school of higher learning during the first fall semester following spring graduation.

C. Has not received an out-of-school suspension while in high school.

3. Eligible students will obtain and complete an application from the counselor's office.

4. All applications must be returned by April 1.

5. The finalists from each school will be given oral interviews to determine the scholarship winner for each school (Gallatin and Winston).

6. Upon selection, the winning students will be notified and asked to give a short presentation at the first Lions Club meeting in May (The first Thursday at 6:30 pm).
