**Let's learn about zoo animals!**

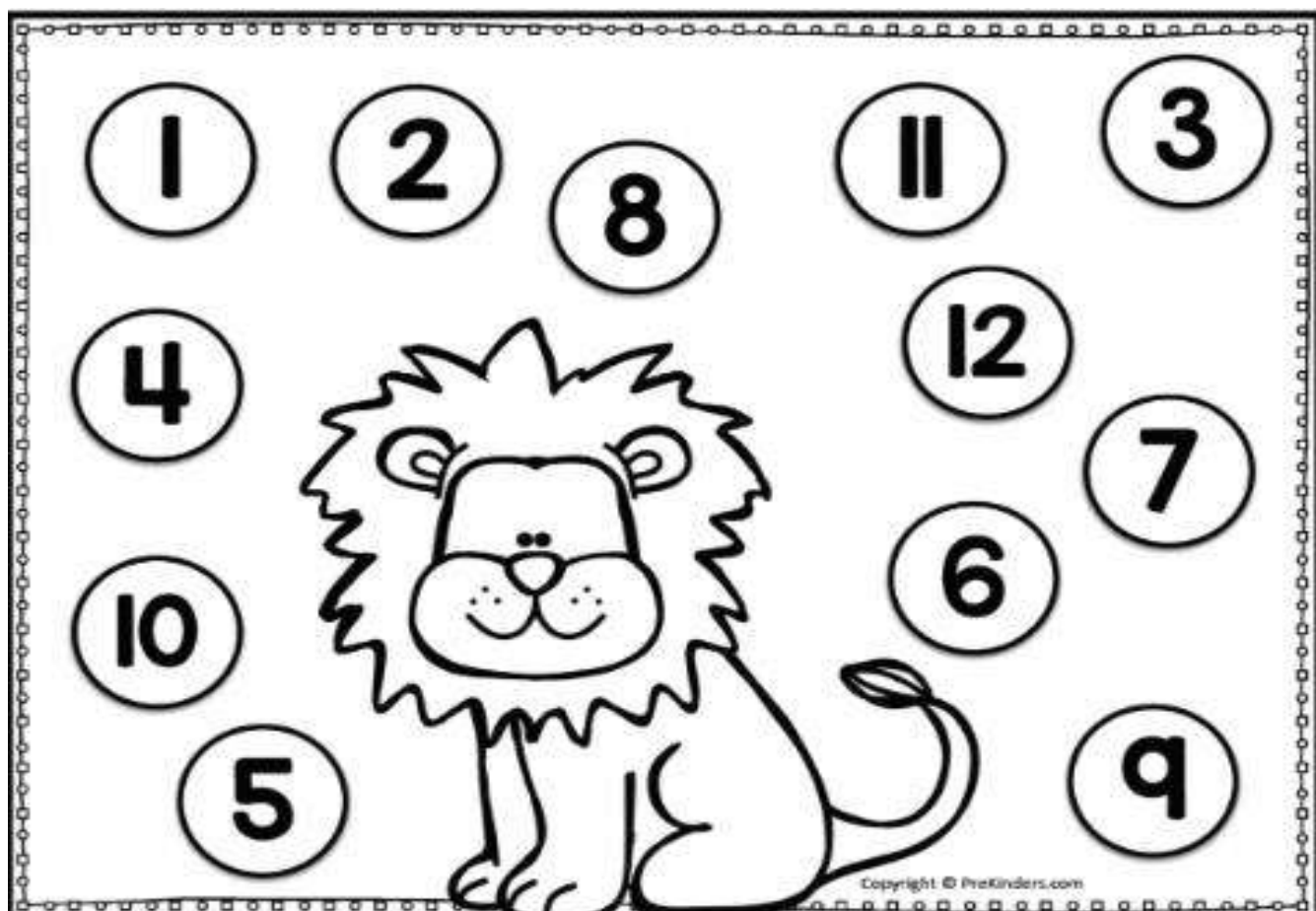
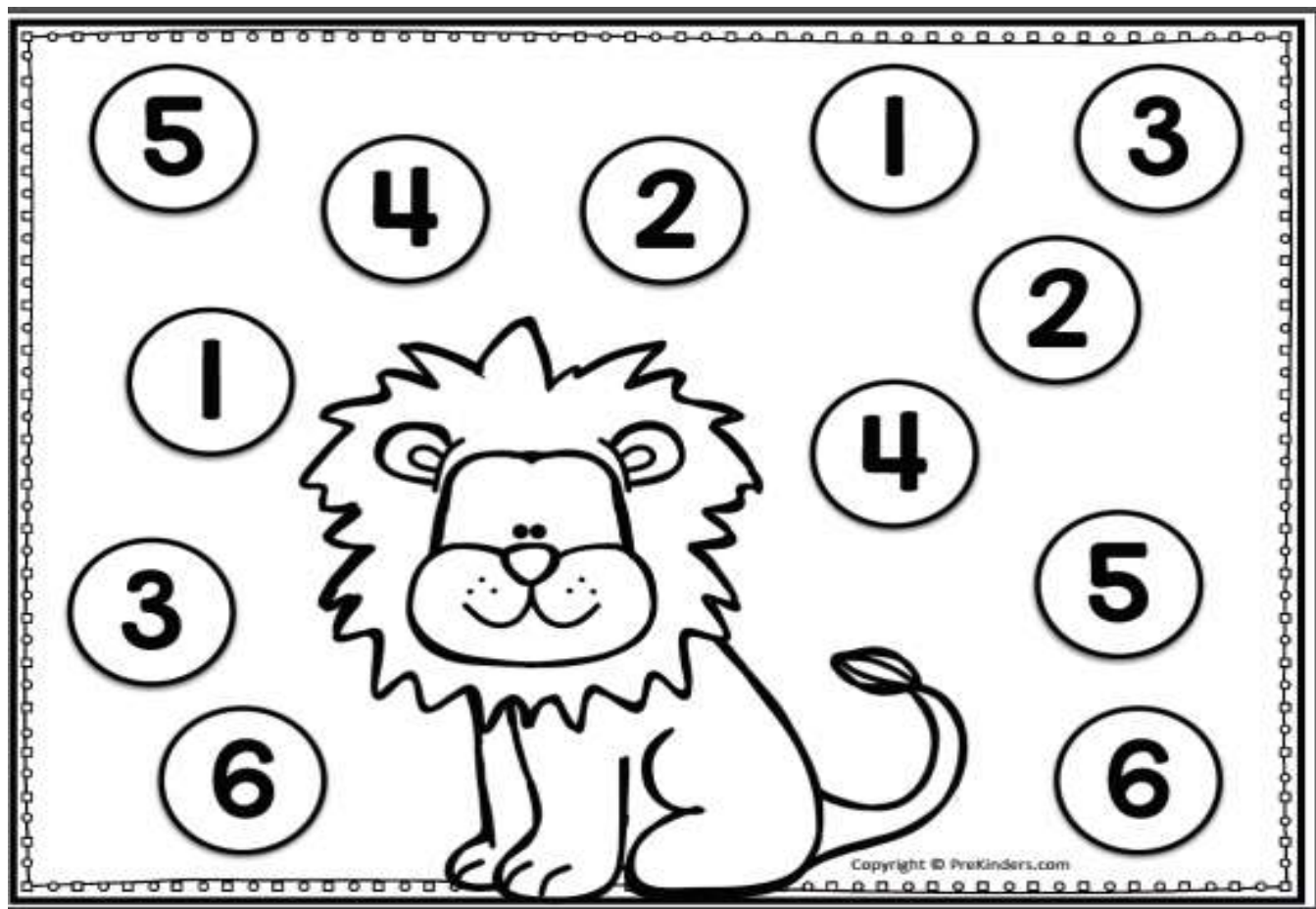
**choose 1-2 assignments each day. You can either send a collage of what you have done for the week on Friday or send me a message daily of 1 activity you completed.**
