You may work alone or in a group of 2, 3, or 4 people. If you work alone or in a small group, you may recruit family or friends to help you make the movie.

Retell a Greek or Roman myth or write an original story about one of the Ecce Romani characters with narration and dialogue in Latin:

Your script must include the following grammatical constructions:

- a comparative or superlative adjective
- a relative pronoun (qui, quae, quod)
- an ablative absolute clause
- an indirect statement clause
- a subjunctive clause
- a deponent verb

Present your skit either live or in a movie.

Criteria for evaluation:

Simple but accurate retelling of myth or story with all grammatical constructions included

Correct Latin forms.

Use of props and costumes

Memorized dialogue or effective use of cue cards – correct Latin pronunciation

If making a movie, consider using subtitles in either Latin or English

Typed script of Latin and English translation with unfamiliar vocabulary listed.
