## Lions as Problem Solvers

Over the last several newsletters we have highlighted the 21st Century skills that every student at Lava Ridge learns over the course of their career as a Lion. These have included becoming strong readers, writers, and mathematicians, and learning the "4 Cs", creativity, collaboration, communication, and critical thinking. Problem Solving is another skill we know we must develop in all of our students so they can be most successful in their world. Problem solving is a process in which students learn to be responsible for some of their learning to solve challenges, resolve conflicts, discuss alternatives, and focus on their thinking. In a classroom setting, problem solving can take a number of different forms and often involves students applying what they have learned to meaningful, real-world activities to challenge students to work at higher levels of thinking.
