Lawn Service Bid Document

The Wright City R-II School District is seeking bids for lawn service for the 2025 calendar year. The District would like the option to renew the contract for an additional one (2026) or two (2027) calendar years.

The successful bidder must agree to the following conditions:

- Must provide a certificate of liability insurance for \$1,000,000 naming Wright City R-II School District as an additional insured.
- Must carry statutory amounts for Workers' Compensation insurance.
- Must participate in E-Verify. Employees must be verified within 30 days of the bid award and to continue using E-Verify throughout the life of the contract. New employees must be verified within 3 days (Form DL0018526 will be provided.)
- Per board policy, no registered sex offenders are allowed on District property.
- Per board policy, no firearms, alcohol, tobacco or illegal substances are allowed on District property.
- Successful bidders must coordinate with the Athletic Director, Administrators, and building maintenance staff on the calendar of events. The contact point for the district will be the Athletic Director.
- The district may add or subtract parcels to be cut marked as needed basis.
- Either party may terminate the contract for failure to perform within service specifications with a 21 day written notice.
- Successful bidders will be responsible for any property damage. This includes mats, sprinkler heads, mailboxes, curbs, etc..
- Various mowing patterns will be employed to ensure the even distribution of clippings
 and to prevent ruts in the turf caused by mowers. Grass clippings will be left on the lawn
 to restore nutrients, unless excess clippings create an unsightly appearance.
- Mowers should be set for 3-¾" min. cutting height during the season. As grass becomes
 dormant in the fall, the height shall be lowered to 3" min. height for the final cutting
 before winter.

Bid Submittal Forms: Submit the following in order for the Bid to be considered complete.

- Bid Form: This form must be signed and dated with all information requested completed.
- References (Past or Current): Minimum of three (3) references that include company name, contact person, and current telephone number.
- 3. Federal W-9 Form: Completed and signed copy of the current edition.

Bids are to be broken down into the following geographical areas due to the varying usage of our properties. Depending on the weather conditions, you may mow more or less than 25 times. This applies to the other cut seasons as well (12, 4, etc....) Service for cut seasons should include mowing, trimming, and cleaning walks and parking lots of grass clippings. Parking lots should be trimmed if vegetation starts to grow. Trimming will be done concurrent with each mowing. The edge of the turf will be trimmed around all sidewalks, curb lines, concrete and asphalt play areas, playgrounds, valve boxes, meter boxes, backflow devices, or any other structures located within the turf areas will be edged as often as necessary to maintain a neat and manicured appearance. Our property extends to public streets. Property must be maintained up to these streets which include Bell Road, Westwoods Road, and Wildcat Drive.

- 1. East Elementary School 3675 West Meyer, Foristell, MO 63348
 - a. North fence to south property line, to west fence, to east side of the asphalt play area located on the east side of the building. (25 cut season)
 - From the asphalt play area east to property line, south to property line, north to property line, including the practice baseball field. (12 cut season)
- Bus Garage 50 Wildcat Drive, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. Around the detention basin fence, along the bus road, from Wildcat Drive to the west fence at the bus garage and inside the bus parking fence area. Include a 10' cut path and trim along the inside and outside of the parking area fence. (12 cut season)
 - Detention basin west of Wildcat Drive, north of the bus garage, south of West Elementary. (4 cut season)
- 3. Early Childhood Center 80 Bell Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. Please see map for area that needs to be cut (25 cut season)
 - Brush hog field bordered by Bell Road to the West, Central Office building to the north, bus garage to the east and the church property to the south. (As needed basis)

- Central Office 90 Bell Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. Please see map for area that needs to be cut (25 cut season)
- Middle School 100 Bell Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - West to Bell Road to north ofWestwoods Road and south to the tree line by the bus garage. East side will split the difference between MS and West Elementary. (25 cut season)
- 6. West Elementary 100 Wildcat Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. Please see map for the area that needs to be cut. (25 cut season)
- 7. High School 520 Westwoods Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - Any area that is east of the west entrance that would be considered building/parking lots. This includes the west side of the building around the greenhouse. (25 cut season)
- High School Athletic Fields 520 Westwoods Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. All remaining areas from above. This is the ground to the west of the west gate/fence, which includes playing fields A, B, C, Softball/Baseball Field, and Stadium Field. Track surface must be covered with 4'x8' sheets of plywood (½ minimum) before driving across. Plywood may be stored under the bleachers. All track surfaces must be blown clean. This includes main track, pole vault, triple jump, shot put, high jump and pads. (25 cut season)
 - b. Detention basin next to Field A. (4 cut season)
 - c. Turf fertilization for playing fields A, B, C, Softball/Baseball Field, and Stadium field. Mechanically broadcast or individually apply fertilizer three (3) times per year during the months of March, May, and September.
 - March-Fertilize to promote recovery from winter dormancy, weed control and pre-emergent to control crabgrass.
 - May-Fertilize with a balanced fertilizer to maintain rich green color during high temperatures, apply broadleaf weed control, apply the second half of pre-emergent to increase season long control of crabgrass.
 - iii. September/October- Fertilize with a heavy rate of slow release fertilizer to provide a nutrient source for developing roots throughout the winter.
 - d. Aeration for playing fields A, B, C, Softball/Baseball Field, and Stadium field. Based on temperatures and in coordination with the Owner, aerate annually during fall. (September-October) Apply slit-seeded or aerate-seed and fertilize within one week after seeding.
- 9. Weed Control and Trimming of Parking Lots
 - a. Spraying weeds in all parking lots and gravel road leading from the bus garage to the Early Childhood Center. Afterward, trimming weeds in all parking lots and gravel road leading from the bus garage to the Early Childhood Center. This will be done four times a year. (Four times per season: April, May/June, August, October.)

- 10. New High School 159 Roelker Road, Wright City, MO 63390
 - a. All grass areas on the property starting at Roelker Road and moving east to the baseball/softball field will need to be moved and trimmed. This includes everything around the school.
- 11. New High School Athletic Fields 159 Roelker Road, Wright City, MO 63385
 - a. Turf fertilization for playing fieldSoftball/Baseball Field (outfield), and practice soccer field. Mechanically broadcast or individually apply fertilizer three (3) times per year during the months of March, May, and September.
 - March-Fertilize to promote recovery from winter dormancy, weed control and pre-emergent to control crabgrass.
 - May-Fertilize with a balanced fertilizer to maintain rich green color during high temperatures, apply broadleaf weed control, apply the second half of pre-emergent to increase season long control of crabgrass.
 - September/October- Fertilize with a heavy rate of slow release fertilizer to provide a nutrient source for developing roots throughout the winter.
 - Aeration for playing fieldSoftball/Baseball Fielda (outfield) and practice soccer field. Based on temperatures and in coordination with the Owner, aerate annually during fall. (September-October) Apply slit-seeded or aerate-seed and fertilize within one week after seeding.
