Ryan's Story-Halligan Assembly - October 10th

On October 10th, John Halligan will be presenting at LCJSMS in two assembly appearances for students and one assembly for parents.

The parent assembly will be held at 7 pm in the middle school auditorium.

In 2003, Mr. Halligan lost his middle-school-aged son, Ryan, to suicide. Mr. Halligan helped create the Vermont Bullying Prevention Law in honor of his son. In 2006, his efforts led to the passing of a law which requires education about the prevention of suicide in public schools.

Since the passing of Vermont Bullying Prevention Law, Mr. Halligan has continued to spread awareness and prevention of bullying, cyberbullying, and teen suicide in both the United States and

abroad. Additionally, he has made appearances on Oprah, Primetime with Diane Sawyer, and PBS Frontline.
