Objectives: TLWBAT

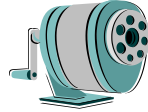

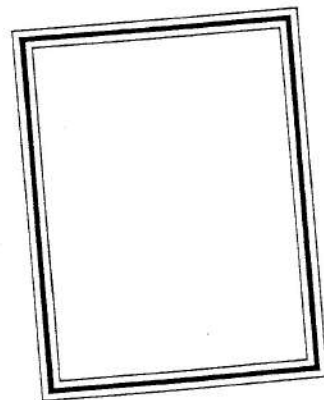
