Be On Time – Classroom

Setting: Classroom

Skill and Critical Rule: “Today we are going to talk about being on time to class.”

What are some reasons why we should be on time?

Ask students to define what being on time means in different classes.

Demonstration and Role Playing

Examples:

Reasons to Be on Time in the Classroom	Disadvantages of Not Being on Time
Shows respect for learning by being present when class starts.	Student might miss important information or assignments at the beginning of class.
Shows respect for learning and others by allowing teachers to start class on time.	Teacher might not have enough time to explain important information fully. Teacher and student might react in a negative manner.
Shows respect for self by managing time well.	Poor grades because of missed information. Disciplinary action will be taken. (conference with Mr. Jamieson, Mrs. Stringer, O.S.S.). Disciplinary actions can cause students to miss out on classroom information and activities.

If you choose to use role-playing, remember that students may only model positive behaviors. Teacher should always model negative behaviors.

Optional Enrichment Activities:

- Students can time selves going from locker to class.
- Problem-solve ways to manage time in hallway.
