Lesson Plan - "Clover Stamping"

<u>Materials</u>

- White paper
- Wine corks, grouped in 3 to create a clover shape Secure with elastic
- Trays with many shades of green paint, blue paint
- Paintbrushes, sponges, dish scrubbers, forks, etc

Instructions

Part 1

Students will paint a green background on the paper, to simulate grass. They can use a variety of painting tools to create this effect

- 1. Put on **apron**
- 2. Give students a piece of paper
- 3. Students choose 2 or 3 different colours of green paint, paint the background paper green, to look like grass.

Part 2

Students stamp clovers on to background

- 4. Dip clover into one of the paint colours, stamp onto paper
- 5. Repeat stamping with a variety of green colours.
- 6. Create stem for clover, if desired.
- 7. Wash hands in water buckets previously prepared if student is in wheelchair. Mobile students can walk to sink to wash paint off of hands.
