

Lesson Plan

“Cupcake Flowers”

Read students “planting a flower” by Lois Elhart. They will create cupcake flowers.

Materials

Cupcake holders and coffee filters
Markers, bingo dabbers, crayons, etc
Background paper (printer paper)
Thin green stems and leaves – students can cut these out
Coloured sequins and glitter
Glue
Smocks

Instructions

(hand-over-hand assistance where needed)

1. Students choose between large or small flower (muffin holder vs. coffee filter)
2. Colour inside of muffin liners with markers (bingo dabber, crayons, etc)
3. Glue coloured muffin liners onto background paper
4. Glue on stem, leaves
5. Squirt some glue into muffin liner, students can add glitter or sequins to decorate

**** IF students are engaged, proceed with extension:**

6. Add more flowers, stems, leaves
7. Draw on background paper
