<b>Grade</b>	12
<b>Topic</b>	Financial Literacy
<b>Goal</b>	To help students understand relevant terms and trends in the financial world.
<b>Activities/ Procedures</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Show introductory video for financial literacy lesson (if you have access to computer/laptop): <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=l_ZbOPnL7_M">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=l_ZbOPnL7_M</a> (you only have to play up to the 4 minute mark)</li><li>2. Distribute “Financial Literacy Quiz” – students can work in groups of 3 or 4. Have students answer questions and then explain answers. Feel free to offer any personal advice to them about loans, debt, etc. (There is an answer sheet for you to reference).</li><li>3. Distribute “Sample Budget Worksheet”; discuss the breakdown of expenses. It would be helpful to do an example (you can estimate costs) – this will give them a realistic look at expenses and saving.
