Lesson Plan

Sand Foam

<u>Materials</u>

Sand – approximately 3 cups
Shaving Foam – x 1 can 250g (approximately)
Large trays or buckets to put Sand Foam in
Smocks
** Optional *** cars, dinosaurs, other sensory bits to hid in foam.

Mix sand and shaving cream together in large container until fully mixed. Add sensory bits in if desired.

Instructions

(hand-over-hand assistance where needed)

- 1. Put on apron
- 2. Give students a container with sand foam in it
- 3. Students explore texture and properties of sand foam. Exploratory sensory play, no outcome required.
- 4. Wash hands in water buckets previously prepared if student is in wheelchair. Mobile students can walk to sink to wash paint off of hands.

^{*} note: to save Sand Foam, cover with saran wrap or put in container with lid. If it hardens, add a little water and mix it in.
