Lesson Plan

"Sand Paper Art"

<u>Materials</u>

Sandpaper Coloured chalk Cornstarch Crayons Food colouring Smocks

Instructions

(hand-over-hand assistance where needed)

- 1. Put on apron
- 2. Prepare liquid chalk: Equal parts cornstarch and water along with a few drops of food color or liquid water colors will give you liquid chalk. (If the liquid chalk is pretty watery, the chalk doesn't flake off after drying. In fact it gives the art a wonderful dimension and creates beautiful texture).
- 3. Give student a piece of sand paper, have student rub hands across it. Use terms like rough and scratchy.
- 4. Students either draw with chalk over sand paper or paint on it.
- 5. If they paint, make sure they brush moves over the sand paper providing a pleasing sensory experience.
- 6. Done!!
