

Lesson Plan

“Scratch Art”

Students will create their own scratch card by colouring a piece of cardstock and then covering it with black paint. Once it dries, it can be scratched off to create beautiful designs.

Materials

White card stock
Coloured crayons or pastels
Black tempera paint
Smocks

Instructions

(hand-over-hand assistance where needed)

1. Put on apron
2. Tape edges of cardstock to create a margin.
3. Cover entire cardstock with crayon or pastel. You can either use multiple colours or just one colour, although it will look better with multiple colours.
4. Now, cover entire crayon/pastel cardstock with a thin layer of tempera paint.
5. Done!!
