<u>Lesson Plan – Snowy Owl</u>

Materials

- blue construction paper
- paint white
- bubble wrap
- Owl body 1 medium oval and one small circle
- Strips of textured white wall paper
- Brown wallpaper
- glue
- Mini muffin cups
- Very small yellow circles
- Black marker

Directions

- 1. Paint a snowy background on light blue paper. Use small pieces of plastic bubble-wrap and white paint, the children can print patterns of small white dots across the paper surface.
- 2. While the paint dries, the children can make their owls. Glue a circle of brown paper onto an oval shape of the same colour, to create the owl's head and body.
- 3. Give each child several strips of the textured wallpaper, and show them how to tear them into small pieces.
- 4. Create eyes by gluing circles of yellow paper inside two small muffin cases, and drawing two black circles in the centre of each. Add a black triangle for the beak.
- 5. Roughly tear a strip of brown wallpaper, creating a tree branch for their snowy owl to perch upon.
