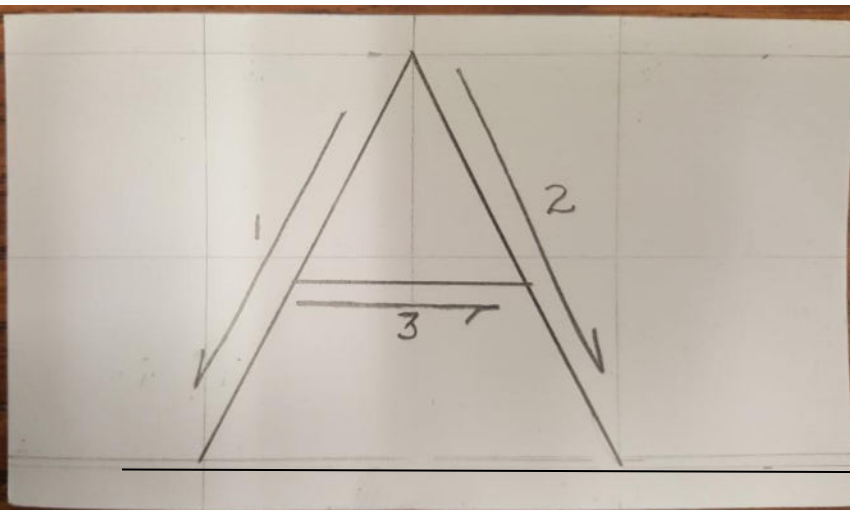


# Lettering for Drafting Assignment

Making sure that your writing is legible is important when most of the communication you do is through writing. Architects have realized this and have a standardized alphabet. We will be practicing the standardized alphabet and numbers and we will use it throughout the semester from this point forward.

Take one note card per letter:

On one side of the card, write the instructions for the letter or number like this.



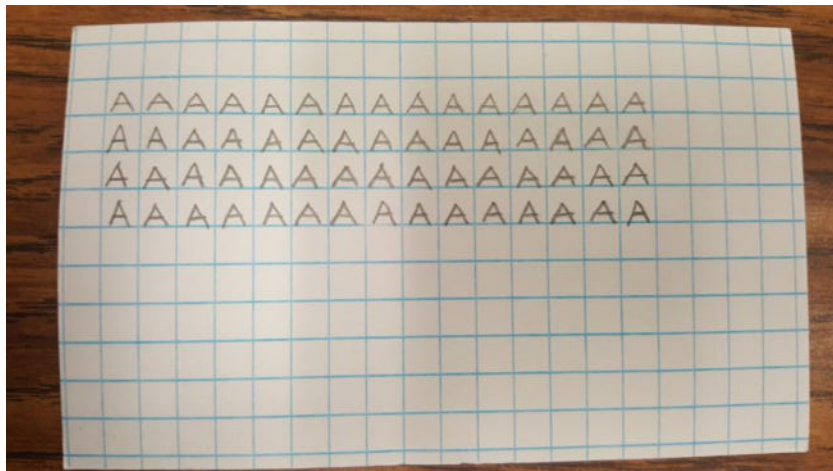
\*Be sure to include the arrows and number of each arrow.

These explain how you should be attempting to write them on

the back

Flip the card over: [gridded work best, but you may used lined. Just be sure to not make the letters/numbers wider than they are tall.]

Write the letters using the order from the instructions, do not fall back on your old habit of how you write the letter. You are learning something new.



- Do 15 letters/numbers across
- Do 4 rows
