## Friday Update – April 9, 2021

**In-Person Learning Update:** Students participating in in-person learning will begin attending in-person CMS classes every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday beginning on 4/12/21. An updated Levine academic calendar is available at <https://bit.ly/LMCHSCalendar2021>.

**NEW Health Screening Update:** Beginning on Monday, 4/12/21, CMS will no longer require temperature checks before students enter buildings/classrooms. However, students will continue to be required to complete the health screening questions daily and face coverings are still required at all times. Physical distance will be encouraged to the greatest extent possible in classrooms and common areas.

**Camp CMS!** Camp CMS is a free, full-day summer learning experience for K-12 students with in-person learning, Monday-Thursday, plus physical activities and enrichment. The registration window is now open. Grades 9-12 will include all EOC subjects, credit recovery, and some elective courses.
