Set up the scene

Figure out a spot on campus where you'd like to take your photos. It should be in a well lit area without a lot of foot traffic (no one walking behind your subject). Try to avoid trash cans in your image.

Image 1: Levitation



Set up your scene. Be sure you subject is IN FOCUS. Make sure the object they are on is not in front of any part of their body. Take the photo.

Image 2: The background



Remove the subject and their object used to prop them up. Do NOT change any setting on the camera OR move it. Take another photo.


