LINE Photography Challenge



Line is an Element of Art. It is One Dimensional mark with direction and length and it is used to lead the eye around a composition. There are numerous varieties of possible lines, curved, bent, straight, thin, thick, jagged, horizontal and vertical. Lines can create shapes, forms and spaces.

Explore your surrounds and look for **LINE** or create line using found objects/ environment. Take a series of photographs using digital SLR or mobile phone. Focus on LINE as your subject matter





LINE photography could include the following:

- Wooden floor boards/ decking, fence
- Forks, Knives, kitchen utensils
- Windows
- Guitar strings
- Stairs
- Cables
- Pegs, clothes line
- Piano/ keyboard
- Sport equipment: bike, football, boot laces
- Tree, plants, flowers



Step 1: Find a **LINE**. Look around your local environment. Scan natural and man-made objects/ environment until you find an interesting leading line.



Step 2: Once you have found an interesting LINE. Take a couple of photographs from different angles. Remember lines don't need to be straight. Lines can be squiggly, curved, vertical..
