LinkIt Goals/Usage	
2019-2020 School Year	Introduced the LinkIt platform to teachers. Group of teachers was trained by LinkIt consultant who then provided turnkey training to staff.
	Teachers began using the platform to create assessments for use in their individual classes.
2020-2021 School Year	LinkIt benchmarks given 2x per semester in English I, II, III and Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II courses (beginning and end of semester)
	Sending schools administer benchmark and honors test via LinkIt for placement purposes at SHS
	Teachers continue to create and administer their own classroom assessments in LinkIt
2021-2022 School Year	Teachers continue to create and administer their own classroom assessments in LinkIt. Some teachers have become "high level" users and provide support to others.
	Teachers create common summative assessments using LinkIt to enable data analysis and comparisons between classes and teachers.
2022-2023 School Year	Teachers will be trained on the data reporting features of LinkIt. PLCs will allow time for data analysis of benchmarks, classroom assessments, and common assessments so that teachers can make instructional decisions based on standards-aligned data.
