This school year marks the first time LMHS has used Family Connection from Naviance to help communicate and organize post-secondary planning. Among the primary resources provided by this tool are multiple interest inventories, job shadow opportunities and requests, college searches, application submission, transcript requests, and career searches and matches.

Family Connection began through the College and Career Center, and is used as a communication tool between students, parents, and counselors regarding post-secondary planning. As of this date, more than 250,000 emails have been sent on post-secondary planning reminders and information from the College and Career Center. The tool is also available for 8th grade students to use in High School Prep classes.

2016-17 PROGRAM OF STUDIES

Course Registration for the 2016-17 school year began on January 21, 2016. Online registration for 8th grade students begins on February 1. All course registration is online using PowerSchool and ends on February 12, at 4:00 p.m. for grades 8th-11th.

NO HOMEROOM IN FEBRUARY-MARCH

There are no Homeroom sessions for the remainder of 3rd Quarter. Homeroom classrooms will be used during Iowa Assessments in April. One more Homeroom date is scheduled for this year on Thursday, April 7, prior to taking the Iowa Assessment and NWEA.

GRADE TRANSCRIPTS

Unofficial student transcripts are mailed at the end of 1st and 2nd semesters. If you would like a copy of an official, signed transcript, contact the Registrar in the 11th-12th Grades Office (447-3045) to make the request. Unofficial transcripts are available any time on PowerSchool.

Students must now send transcripts to prospective colleges or institutions using Family Connection. Students needing help in setting up their Family Connection accounts should see their counselor or stop by either the 9th-10th Grades Office or 11th-12th Grades Office.

Seniors must request that final transcripts be sent following graduation to their chosen colleges or post-secondary institutions.

Seniors must make the request for a final transcript to be sent on Family Connection and with the Registrar in the 11th-12th Grades Office.

LMHS Renovation Update

The renovation project at LMHS continues. Hallway floor and ceiling tiles are currently being replaced. Work has started on the new Wrestling Room and Weight Room.

The new Family and Consumer Science labs and a computer lab were opened in December. Progress on the North and South additions continues, with completion for both areas scheduled for July 31, 2016. South addition construction is ahead of schedule at this time. The North addition includes the orchestra room, eleven classrooms, 9th-10th Grades office, and student areas. The South addition includes a large student area, College and Career Center, School Store, 11th-12th Grades office, and Athletic office.

Renovation of eighteen classrooms is scheduled to begin this summer. Renovation of the Media Center/Learning Center, presentation/lecture hall will begin this summer and fall. The entire project is scheduled for completion in December of 2016.

BUILDING ENTRANCE FOR EVENTS SCHEDULED IN THE MAIN OR AUXILIARY GYMS

Events occurring this winter and spring in either the Main or Auxiliary Gyms will continue to use Door #14 for entry. Door #14 is located on the south side of the building, and there are two large banners that read, 'Gymnasium Entrance'. Use of this door allows for better access from the South Parking Lot. Hall signage has been posted to help visitors find the gyms. We thank everyone for your patience during the renovation at LMHS.

STUDENT TUTORING REQUESTS

Request forms for receiving a student peer or adult tutor may be found in the 9th-10th Grades Office, the 11th-12th Grades Office, or online. As many requests as possible are matched with a tutor. Tutoring takes place in forty-five minute sessions between 7:30 a.m. and 4:20 p.m. in The Learning Center/Media Center, The Upper Commons/Library, or in the Main Office.

8th Grade Parent Course Registration Night on Monday, February 8

8th Grade Parent Course Registration Night will be held on Monday, February 8. The meeting is open to all 8th Grade parents. Students are welcome to attend. **The main session will be held in the LMHS Auditorium beginning at 7:00 p.m.** The session will take about forty-five minutes. Beginning at 5:30 p.m., parents and students may tour renovated classrooms and visit with teachers in the Design/Engineering/ Materials, Agri-Aqua-Science, Art, and Family and Consumer Science departments. Beginning at 6:00 p.m., in the Media Center/Learning Center, parents and students may meet with teachers to discuss course choices. Three drop-in sessions will also be held at 5:45, 6:15, and 6:45 p.m. These drop-in sessions will be ten minutes and focused on the following topics: 1) Grading/Assessment and Academic Planning; 2) RTI/ Academic Support/The Learning Center Concept; 3) Family Connection/RAI/College and Career Center.

DR. EDDIE MOORE BRINGS MESSAGE OF DIVERSITY PREPAREDNESS TO LMHS

Recently, LMHS staff and students worked with Dr. Eddie Moore on preparing for teaching and succeeding in a diverse world. On January 18, Dr. Eddie Moore presented a message to LMHS staff about being prepared to work with an increasingly diverse student population. Dr. Moore stated, "The best friend of hate is silence. When you know something is wrong, say something." He cautioned that educators need to prepare students and ourselves with the skills to interact with all components of a diverse student population.

On January 19, Dr. Moore met with all grade levels with a message to students that they must develop the skills necessary to live and work in a diverse environment. Dr. Moore asked students to look beyond the narrow lens of our environments to see that there is more than one way for individuals to view the world and people around them. A group of students also met with Dr. Moore during a luncheon.
