2015 BJH Music Department Lip Sync Competition Rules

- Registration begins on Wednesday, September 30 and closes Wednesday, October 7. Registration is online (<u>https://docs.google.com/forms/d/</u> <u>1HuL7xQ_4cnqYVgVgeFCwLCcrfjyOGCyRpqyGPnXZZDo/viewform?</u> <u>usp=send_form</u>). Registration forms are also available in the Main Office.
- 2. The entrance fee for each participant is \$2.
- 3. Only the first 12 acts registered will perform, the next 5 will be alternates.
- 4. Individuals may only perform in one act.
- 5. You must check in by 6:00 PM on the night of the show or you may not be able to perform.
- 6. The show begins at 6:30 PM and is expected to last about one hour and 30 minutes.
- 7. Your group (or individual) must supply their own music—either a CD in good condition or mp3 (cued iPod is OK).
- 8. Maximum time limit for your performance or song will be limited to no more than 3 minutes 30 seconds. At 3 minutes 30 seconds, all music will be faded out.
- 9. All songs and performance must be in good taste! This is a family event for all ages. Any performance done in poor taste will be interrupted and that performer will be disqualified.
- 10. You are responsible for all of your own props.
- 11. The competition will be judged in these categories:
 - Lip Sync Abilities: How well the performer(s) lip-sync the lyrics of the song.
 - **Creativity:** How original and creative the performance is. Instead of just standing on stage and lip-syncing a song, props, costumes and/or other ideas should be used and often impresses the judges and generates crowd response. Be creative!
 - Stage Presence & Choreography: Engage the audience, dance, smile, make eye contact with the judges and HAVE FUN!

The act with the highest score wins. The Judges' decisions are final! A second prize for the "Audience Choice" will also be awarded.
