




#### How to make your puppets:


- 1. Collect the materials you will need to create your paper bag puppets:
- Paper bags (sized approximately 6 x 11 inches)
- Scissors
- Glue
- · Colored pencils, crayons or markers if using the black & white version.
- 2. Print out the puppet pieces that you need from the following pages. Color the pieces if using the black & white version.
- 3. Cut out the puppet pieces.
- 4. Glue the pieces on to the bag: The top of the head is glued on to the bottom flap of the bag. The chin is pasted under this flap so when you put your hand into the puppet and move this flap up and down, it looks like your puppet is singing or talking.
- 5. You're ready to play with your new puppet! Have fun!




